1. Fundraising page - Login

Go to the Feast for Freedom website feastforfreedom.org.au

Click on the "Login" button in the top right corner.



Log in as a Host with the email address and password you used during registration.

Forgot your password? Don't worry, you can reset it by clicking [Forgot password?](#)


2. Fundraising page & dashboard

My Feast Guests

“My Feast Guests” gives you the option to show or hide the details of your feast.

If you choose to show this on your fundraising page it will be public to anyone that finds your page and guests can automatically RSVP to your feast.

You can edit;

- The location of your Feast.
- The date of your Feast and time of your Feast
- Maximum no. of guests
- Edit and update guest details

Host Resources

“**Host Resources**” tab gives you access to printable resources. There are items not included in your host kit including a menu template and invitation.

Share and Invite

“**Share and Invite**” allows you to share the URL of your fundraising page directly to Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn. You can copy the fundraising page URL and share it via email or messaging apps.

My Donations

“**My Donations**” lets you see donations made to your page.

When you receive a donation it will appear in the donor section . You can thank your donors directly, either by Facebook or by email.

Edit My Page


“**Edit my Page**” - update details that are visible on your fundraising page.

Update basic information, including your personal URL and your fundraising target as well as add blog posts or images.

Note: changing the URL of the fundraising page may render any previous links formerly sent out invalid.

3. Your fundraising page as it appears to others

To see what other people see when they look up your Feast, click on the “View” button on your fundraising page.



Your friends and colleagues can;

- Make a donation.
- See the details of your Feast and RSVP to your Feast - if you have turned this function on.

From this view as a host you can;

- Share your progress through the blog and gallery.
- Share your fundraising page directly to various social media platforms.
- Edit the message you want your guests to see by clicking on the small pen icon above your story title.
- Provide updates, such as your cooking journey or your reflections once your Feast is completed.
- Add photos from your preparations and your Feast:

RSVP TO THIS FEAST

When a guest RSVPs to your Feast:

- They will receive a confirmation email.
- You will receive an email letting you know that you have a guest who has registered for your Feast
- "seats available" will decrease
- Guest information will appear in your dashboard in "My Dinner Guests" (this can only be viewed by you).

Guest Donations

Your guests can then make a donation to your Feast. They can click on one of the recommended donation amounts, or they can enter any amount they choose. They will receive a tax-deductible receipt automatically by email.

You can review the donations of each guest in the "My Donations" tab on your dashboard.

4. Recap: Fundraising page vs dashboard

Dashboard You need to be logged into to access this. Here you can review your progress, invite guests, check RSVPs, edit your fundraising page settings and download hosts resources inc. Recipe Book. Only you have access to your dashboard.

Fundraising page is the public facing part of your Feast page. This is where your friends will land when you share your fundraising page with them.
